Campus Expansion and Reinvention

Evolved from extant campus spaces, BPAC is located on the campus at Sandhills Community College (SCC) in the idyllic resort town of Pinehurst. Part of the NC Community College system, SCC was established in 1963 and boasts a 240-acre campus. The college serves approximately 11,000 students each year and offers over 100 unique academic, Workforce Continuing Education and Lifelong Learning programs.

The Perfect Location for Every Occasion

Owens Auditorium

This 588-seat proscenium theater is the flagship venue of BPAC. Named for Dr. Francis L. Owens, it offers modern technology for concerts, theater, dance, lectures, ceremonies and corporate events.



McPherson Theater

This 80-seat black box theater in Wellard Hall offers a flexible, informal, up-close setting for concert, cabaret and theater performances, as well as master classes. Named for Tom and Kathy McPherson, it's a dynamic space for creative expression.



McNeill-Woodward Green

A scenic outdoor venue for graduations, concerts, and events. Named for Drs. Larry McNeill and Mary Margaret Woodward McNeill for their contributions to education and the arts.



Evelyn's Courtyard

The cozy outdoor space between McPherson Theater and Owens Auditorium, perfect for receptions and intimate performances. Dedicated to Evelyn Condon Dempsey, it's an enchanting gathering spot.



Jeanne Hastings Gallery

Showcasing local and student artwork, this gallery located in the Katharine L. Boyd Library offers a half-dozen exhibits annually in a variety of media.

Patrons can enjoy wine, beer, soda and snacks sold by BPAC concessions.
